## SPEECH, LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION

Communication difficulties include problems with speech, voice, understanding and expression of language and social communication.

These can include: cleft lip and palate, deafness or loss of hearing, difficulties with language development, selective mutism, speech sound delay and speech impairment, fluency (stammering), voice disorders, and social communication disorders (such as autism).
