

What does a school visit involve?



A clinician will visit your child in school.

They will see your child in one of their lessons, in their classroom.

The clinician will also see your child at breaktime or lunchtime.

The clinician will spend some time with your child in a quiet room by themselves. Your child may want an adult they know to join them and this is fine. They may do some of the activities from the ADOS and have a chat.

The clinician will talk to an adult who knows your child well. This may be a Teacher, Teaching Assistant or Senco.

The clinician would like to see how your child usually is at school. We are aware that it can feel a bit uncomfortable being watched!

We will try to be as discreet as possible, like we are observing the whole class.

Please reassure your child that we just want to find out how school is for them, what they usually do there and how they like to spend their breaktime.

There is no right or wrong way for them to be. They can just be themselves.
